Science conference

“From body literacy (eurythmy) to ‘literate senses’ and man as  
medium” (Rudolf Steiner and the media)

Dear Sir/Madam,

We are pleased that our proposal for gathering around the thoughts and works of Rudolf Steiner in the sense of the project of **scientific and professional conference titled *In the North with Rudolf Steiner***, dedicated to the life and work of Rudolf Steiner, is encountering good vibrations. Since our first letter, we have received a number of interesting and good suggestions that we would like to share with all potential participants of our meeting.

1. The work does not have to be completed (in final form) until the symposium. At the symposium we will have presentations, and it will be possible to submit the final versions of the texts until the end of the year. This way we would allow all participants to be accepted and become involved in the discussions we will have at the symposium through suggestions.
2. To participate in the symposium, it is important to submit a summary of the work (according to the form you received – Application). Due to summer months, we extended the deadline for sending the summary until 21 September 2017. We hope this will simplify the procedure and allow everyone who wants to participate to apply and prepare for the symposium in time.

3. There have been very interesting initiatives which we believe should be one of the results of our invitation for socialising with Steiner. For example, one of them is the initiative to dedicate some time within the symposium for a round table during which the idea of forming a coordinating body – a section for the “implementation and revival of anthroposophy” – would be presented. We consider this idea welcome, and we also invite other participants to enrich our meeting with their proposals.
4. We also invite all followers of the thought and work of Rudolf Steiner to propose the most deserving persons for the programme and organisational committee of these gatherings. Our wish is that the people with the most experience in promoting the thought of Rudolf Steiner be appointed into the bodies that will coordinate the energies of this symposium. The role of the University North and Dr. Rudolf Steiner Centre is basically a coordinating one. Of course, there is good will, but it has to rely on the knowledge and experience of people who have been promoting Steiner’s ideas for years, and even decades.

We hope that it is clear from this announcement that this is an open initiative that will grow and develop in the determined by the symposium participants themselves. The papers selected by the Programme Committee will be published in the electronic scientific journal *In medias res*, and if we will have a sufficient number of quality scientific papers (which we will submit for scientific review), there is a possibility that the University North will publish a collection of papers from the symposium. Of course, this is just one of the suggestions. We are also open to other possibilities.
